

There are rumours that even Woodworks@Daventry will be back next year. Happy days! Good on Tudor Rose woodturning club.


Not many articles again this month so, unless you want to see lots of me in the newsletter, get writing and send a photo.

#### Hands On Shilton 15/7/2022

Quite a low turnout but those that did attend appeared to have fun. Phil Steele set up his Pole Lathe and I used Graham Ball's lathe to turn pens. A couple of people had a go on the Pole Lathe and I had one volunteer to turn a pen.







I turned my current favourite pen, an Axminster Aromatherapy twist pen. I used a Craft Supplies (now Turners Retreat) acrylic pen blank. This requires its own bushings and a 3/8" drill. After sanding, it was polished with Micromesh pads (1500 - 12000 grit) leaving it nice and shiny.

My volunteer Sarah Hall then turned a simple Axminster Art Deco 7mm twist pen with the same Craft Supplies acrylic pen blank. She made a very nice pen too.



The Pole Lathe with plenty of shavings. Phil demonstrated how to use it and then a couple of people had a go.

My pen display and pen blank display just appear in the bottom corner. Part of my display was a Celtic knot in a pen blank. The four assembly stages were on display as was a black and white multi-segmented pen. Messy to make as glue gets everywhere but much cheaper than buying a ready-made blank from Turners Retreat.


## **Basket Illusion**By Rob Sheehan

The basket illusion was made popular by David Nittmann although many others have practised the craft. I decided to have a go. I first produced a small platter to see what I could achieve. Then I had a go at a hollow(ish) form. I



used a 6mm beading tool to create the beads. I then "cheated" and used my laser engraver to create the burn lines between the rings and the radial lines. It would have been quicker to create the circular lines on the lathe but the radial lines were much easier, faster and probably more accurate done by machine. I did need to manually burn some lines where the engraved lines were a bit light. After planning the pattern on my computer, I coloured the segments with Derwent "Inktense" pencils bought at a show. The prototype showed that lines near the centre didn't work hence the rim on the top and the plain circles on the bottom


