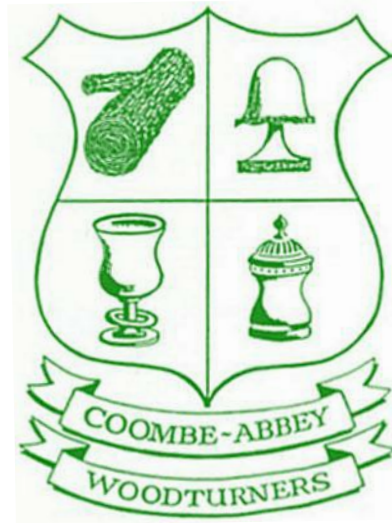

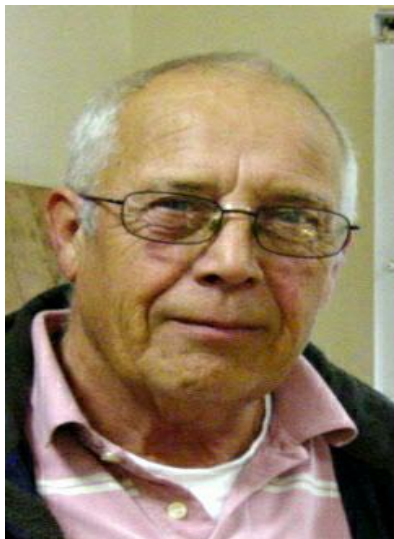

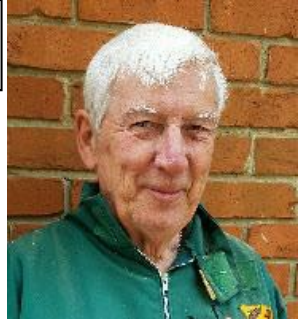

A Demonstration
by
Peter Carless

At Shilton Village Hall on Friday 26th November 2021

One thing you can say about Peter Carless is you are assured of a very interesting demo and that he gives himself plenty of work to do on the occasions that he demonstrates. This demonstration had all sorts of interesting twists. For a start he said he was going to make a “Muffineer” now

I for one had never heard of this term and questioning Peter at the break he showed me on Google the definition of the word and I repeat it here -

Definition of Muffineer: a shaker for sifting sugar on muffins.

Now of course the term can apply to a salt shaker as well as Sugar and it needn't just be for muffins. Peter said he had seen a version of this in Woodturning Magazine but the lid was just pushed on and he felt that there was a danger of this coming off when being shaken over a meal which of course would spoil that meal, so he decided that the lid should be screwed on eliminating that danger.

Peter started by turning two insert rings which he intended to thread chase and glue into the lid and body of the shaker. One to have a female thread and the other a male thread respectively, so he went ahead and gave us a master class of thread chasing and I know

from experience is not at all easy and to do this in front of an audience takes some doing. Eventually this was completed and he then turned the rest of the shaker competently using the spindle gouge. When it came to hollowing Peter gave us another master class of how to use a variety of hollowing tools which he had in his possession. An intriguing one was modelled on a tool originated by Somerset professional woodturner Melvyn Firmager. I have seen this tool demonstrated before and it is far from easy to handle but Peter was very competent in its use. Another hollowing tool was the BCT (Bierton Craft Turnery). I have a couple of these in two sizes and know that a few other club members seem to favour them. I personally find them easy to use and would recommend them to any novice woodturner to add to their toolbox.

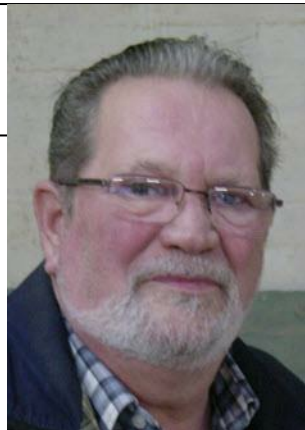

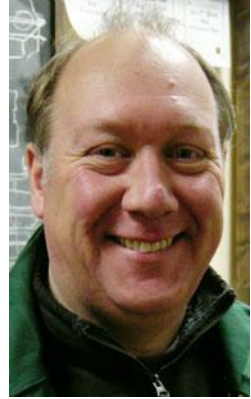
If you are able to take on this responsibility please get in touch with the chairman or any committee member and register your interest in helping the club in this way. Thank You.

Hi Graham,

I trust that you remain well.

Herewith are pictures of recent seasonal projects.



The small tree was made from a scrap of Laburnum, initially intended to become an egg.

As a practice piece for the Axminster demo, I combined Pete Carless' demo piece of a lift-up lidded toothpick holder (having

sought permission) with a Christmas Tree, using an unseasoned log of unknown species. It's about 175mm tall.

Then, due to confusion over what we were supposed to do for Axminster, and for how long each of us was required, I looked up a design for a hanging ornament and made the one shown assembled, as a practice. The bulb section is Elm

and the finial/icicle is Sapele type dark wood. That seemed to be do-able in the time available, so I made another to leave unassembled, with the timber colour reversed ie with dark bulb and pale finial/icicle. The

The snowman salt and pepper set was made from pieces of a Beech table leg. They are about 75mm tall. I mucked up the final hole in the original pepper pot's hat so

turned it off and made a new one in Sapele (unconfirmed) to provide a contrasting visual guide to which shaker is which.

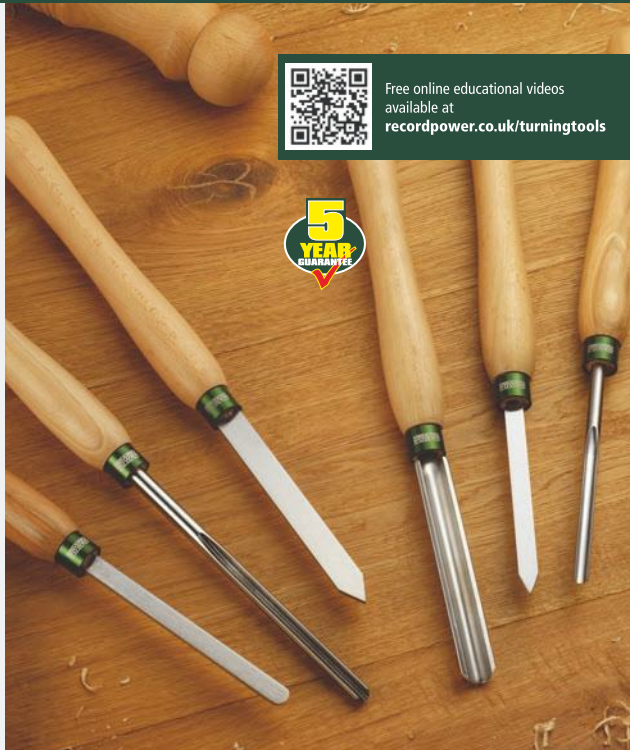
