#### A Demonstration

by

#### **Mick Hanbury**

At Walsgrave Baptist Church on Saturday 23rd October 2021

We have enjoyed demonstrations by Mick Hanbury before and this one was no exception to that trend. Mick always has an interesting project to demonstrate and his demos are always punctuated by his humorous comments.

On this occasion Mick showed us an example of the piece that he was going to turn for us which was a lidded vessel on a raised base and with a finial, a further enhancement was inside the lid making five separate pieces to turn.

An Example Piece

Mick explained the choice and preparation of the wood for the Bowl and lid and then set to work on turning the bowl section. The outside shape was formed first and he used a saw tooth bit in the base to cut a socket for the raised foot to eventually be located in. This socket would also be used to remount the piece in the chuck for turning the inside of the vessel. When Mick was happy with the shape of the piece he turned his attention to the lid which was done in a similar fashion to the bowl but being careful that the sizing was accurate.

This done now it was time to form the base and of course there were a few things to consider namely height, diameter and any ornamental features. Mick discussed all these with us and when decided proceeded to finish the Foot. The finial was the next part to be turned and here again




