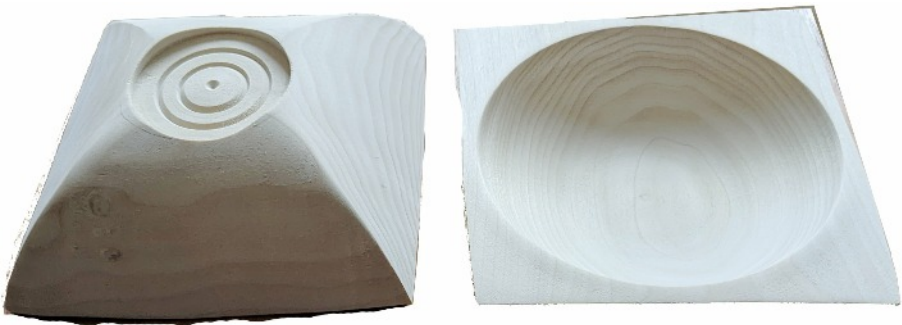
Two-Axis Bowl

Hi Rob,

Following our demo on the two axis bowls I was inspired to have a go but had no idea on how to source suitable wood. Graham Ball kindly offered to size some for me and gave me the name of Sykes Timber in Atherstone. They were very helpful so I went over and bought a piece of poplar which I then dropped off to Graham. After his holiday and mine I went over to Hinckley to collect the pieces. Nick (my husband) and I scrounged some scrap plywood from the Canal & River Trust where we volunteer. Nick cut it to size and did the paper joints for me. I'm quite pleased with the outcome although my finish with the tools wasn't as good as I would have liked. I didn't persevere too long with various grits, settling (as usual) for shape rather than finish. I may use a spray lacquer sometime.

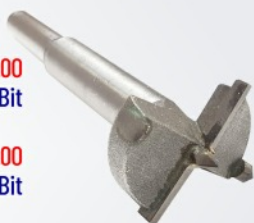

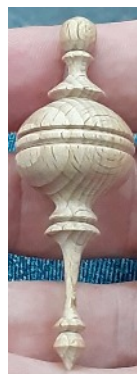

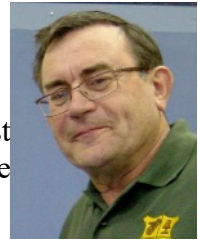
